

CASE STUDY

With a growing family, the owners of this house wanted to make some changes. Rather than move, they remodeled. The Remodeling Company added two additions and extended the full basement while the homeowners continued living in the house through the entire process. To contain the dust and preserve the quality of the air in the house during the remodel, The Remodeling Company used a number of new technologies, including a portable, industrial-strength air purifier.



Challenge

- ▶ custom brass inserts in powder room floor
- ▶ radiant heating throughout first floor
- ▶ metal, standing seam roof
